Class 4 enjoyed a wonderful trip to Long Mynd during which they enjoyed a walk up to the reservoir and carried out scientific investigations on the river which included measuring: the speed of water flow; the range in water depth across the river; and the range in water depth as they went along the river. They also did some river dipping - using nets to collect creatures from the river and then taking them into the lab to look at them in detail and use classification keys to identify them.
