Dear Parents/Carers,

Mrs Holmes was pleased the weather was kind to us but we will make the most of our outdoor area in all weathers so please make sure children come prepared. Through the holiday, we have begun to create a Sensory Garden behind the mobile where children can have some quiet time at break time, listening to wind chimes, smelling the lavender and mint, watching the birds, listening to the rustle of leaves or simply sitting amongst nature. I'm very proud to announce that despite the challenges of Covid last year, Tushingham CE Primary still achieved the Sainsbury's School Games Gold award, recognising our commitment to a high level of PE provision, including competition, and the promotion of both physical and mental wellbeing.

Children are already impressing me as well as teachers and I have awarded several Headteacher's golden stickers for exceptional work. Please join us on a Friday morning for Celebration Worship to celebrate all our children's achievements in and out of school. Bringing certificates, medals and details or photos of achievements out of school is one way we value the uniqueness of each and every child. My favourite is still a Blue Peter badge although we have acrobats amongst our children's talents too.

















I cannot stress enough the importance of labelling your child's items so we can make sure they are not lost. The Friends of Tushingham (FoT – our PTA) are going to hold second-hand uniform sales throughout the year so if you have any 'grown out of but still useable items', please drop them off at the school office. As communicated in the Summer term, our Uniform Policy asks that school jumpers have the school logo but other items do not need to have this on although they are available from Whitchurch Sports, 11A Watergate Street, Whitchurch SY13 1DP or online from RAM Sports, Wrexham. There are some very good deals in local supermarkets. Book bags and PE bags can be purchased from our school office.

It is the FoT Annual General Meeting on Friday 16th September at 3.30pm in the school hall. This is for all parents to share their ideas, listen to ideas and make a plan for fundraising for the year – helping at events makes a real difference. Money raised by the FoT is used to benefit all children, for example by contributing to coach costs for trips or purchasing items identified by school which will benefit all pupils. Currently, the outdoor area is a focus and the FoT have purchased the outdoor speaker system and gazebos. The School Council will oversee decisions made regarding future purchases – there have been lots of ideas suggested. Please do come along on Friday, have a cup of tea and a biscuit and help support the continued development of our school.

For those new to school, when parking in the car park opposite school, please reverse in to avoid reversing out when children could be behind your car. Parking space is limited so allow adequate space between cars but please don't leave excess space so as many cars as possible can park. Please take extra care and drive very slowly when driving on the road outside school and be careful exiting onto the A41 – be aware vehicles travel very fast along this road. Parents and carers are respectfully expected not to stop their cars on the zigzag lines outside school and also to consider our neighbours, ensuring entrances to properties are kept clear at all times. Please do not park in front of the gate to the field. Thank you for helping to keep our children safe.

Attendance at Tushingham is excellent and we want to ensure this continues. Evidence shows that children who miss school do not achieve as well as those who attend regularly – the high achievement of our children reflects this. There may be occasions when your child is too ill to attend school, or they may have an appointment. It is a parent's responsibility to inform school of the reason for absence before a child is absent. In this way, we can safeguard your children by knowing their whereabouts. Any planned absence must be authorised by the Headteacher in advance. Please obtain a form from Mrs Devaney to request authorisation for an absence. As of September 2013, the law has restricted a Headteacher's ability to authorise holidays during term time. Any absence can only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. Unauthorised absences may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued by the Local Authority.

Toddlers - led by Mrs Glassonbury - will be every Monday morning so if you have younger children, please bring them along to this and we can begin to welcome them and you into our school family too. Please share with friends who may be interested.

Following the success of the swimming pool - which was highlighted in the Whitchurch Herald during the summer holiday — two parents are raising money by walking 50 miles on The LongMynd Hike to ensure the return of the pool.
